AMERICAN HEROES

Lynchburg Lemonade

Jack Daniels Tennessee Whiskey

Demandis Curacao Triple sec

Lemon juice and Lime-lemon soda

Created by Alabama lounge and restaurant owner Tony Mason 1980 who later suit Jack Daniels distillery to chord for stealing his trade secret recipe for 13 million dollars. The court ruled his favour but decided to not award him money.

Dark and Stormy

Bacardi Rum Carta Negra

Lime juice, Simple syrup, Angostura orange bitters, Ginger beer

The national drink of Bermuda, where ginger beer and dark rum are produced.

First served in the 1860s in Gaspare Campari's bar in Milano, this was originally known as the "Milano-Torino" as Campari came from Milano and sweet vermouth from Torino. During Prohibition Italians noticed an influx of American who enjoyed the drink and so dubbed it Americano.
